## Parent code of conduct

- 1. I (and my guests) will be a positive role models for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect, courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice and/or other Stallions events.
- 2. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent.
- 3. I will not encourage any behaviours or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of any child.
- 4. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 5. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, colour, sex, or ability.
- 6. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 7. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of all the athletes.
- 8. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place in a calm and civilized manner.
- 9. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

I hereby agree that if I (or other parent, guardian, or guests of my child) fail to conform conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, or participating in a St-Lazare Stallions event I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

- 1) Verbal warning by the head coach, Manager, Association board member and/or league official.
- 2) Written warning.
- 3) Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file.
- 4) Parental season suspension.
